

These are the instructions on viewing the Live Streaming services for St. Peters, for those individuals who do not possess an active Facebook account:

First, go to the Home Page of our website (<https://www.stpeters-norfolk.org/index.html>). You're already there if you're reading this, so.....below, on the right side of the page, next to the photo of the church, is red text that scrolls up with various messages:

Now you are on our Facebook page. You'll see the following pop-up after a few seconds. It will ask you to log in, but notice at the bottom it shows:

Not Now.

Click on that and the screen goes away. Until the live video feed begins, this will pop up every few seconds. Just keep clicking 'Not Now' to make it go away. After the live feed begins, hover your mouse pointer over the video and you shouldn't see any more of these pop-ups.
