The Light of Christ Shines Forth

This Epiphany season, as the Christmas lights dim, a greater light dawns! The word "Epiphany" means "manifestation" or "appearance" of God, and it celebrates the moment Jesus, the Light of the World, was revealed to all nations, not just Israel, through the visit of the Magi.

These wise travelers followed a star, a divine sign, on a long journey, bringing gifts to the newborn King. Their story isn't just about the past; it's a mirror for our own spiritual journey. Like them, we are called to seek Christ, to follow His light even when the path is unclear, and to worship Him with our whole selves.

What Does This Mean for Us?

- **A Call to See:** Epiphany calls us to open our eyes and hearts to see God's presence in new ways—in Scripture, in prayer, in creation, and in "the least of these" around us.


- **A Call to Share:** The light we receive is not meant to be hidden. The Magi were warned in a dream to return home by a different way, a way illuminated by their encounter with Christ. We too are called to be witnesses, to share God's love and justice in dark places, showing the world the glory of Christ.

A Call to Action: This season is a powerful reminder that God is at work, inviting us to new beginnings. What new path is God calling you to? A step of forgiveness, a renewed commitment to prayer, or a greater act of generosity? Let us pray for the courage and vision to follow the Star of Bethlehem, to recognize Christ's glory in our lives and world, and to let His light shine through us, bringing hope and healing to all.

St. Peter's Church was organized in 1885 and the cornerstone was dedicated October 5th, 1886. This structure still stands on Brown Avenue in Norfolk. The first worship service at our present site was in the parish hall on Christmas Eve, 1959. All existing construction was completed in 1965.
